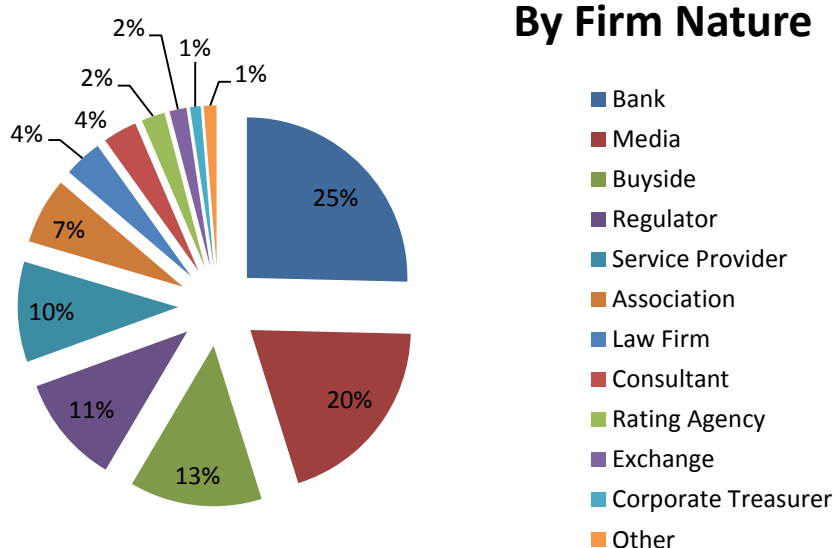

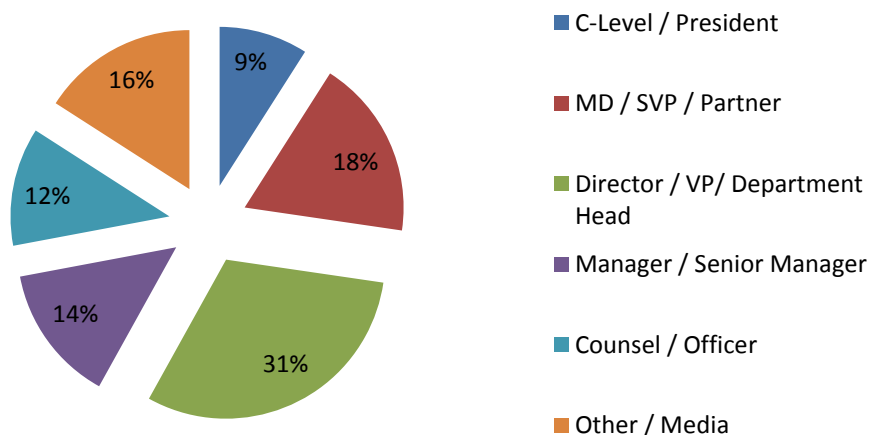


Breakdown of Participating Attendees in 2015:
